## 2. Technical Report

After a short break, following the SUM10A campaign, a new long working period, focused on restoration, has been spent on the site, from the  $3^{rd}$  of April till the end of July.

Goal of this campaign has been the completion of the eastern side of the city wall (walls M139, M140, M199), the beginning of the works on the southern side (wall M200, M201 and M206) together with the isolated tower A171, placed on the eastern side, in front of wall M439.

The excavation of a trench, made by Said Al Mashani, has been done before the restoration works.
